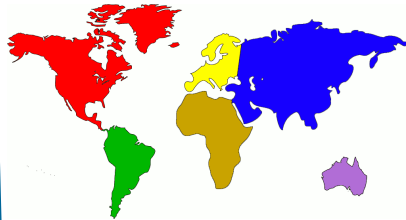


Geography

We will be following Unit 4 of the Music Express Course and singing in tune and in time.

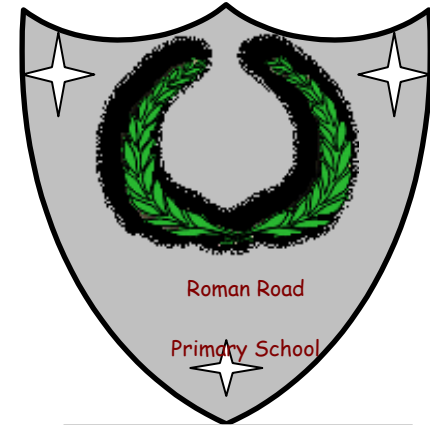


PE

Ask and answer simple questions by counting the number of objects and sorting the categories by quantity
Add and subtract numbers including: a two-digit number and ones; a two-digit number and tens; two two-digit numbers; adding three one-digit numbers
Recognise and use symbols for pounds (£) and pence (p)
