Black History Week is in October

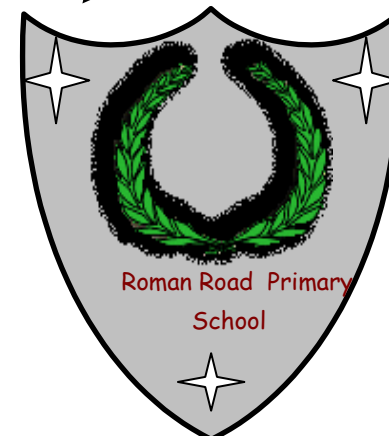


French

This term we will be reading Aesop's fables and learning about the moral of the story. We will also read traditional myths and legends.

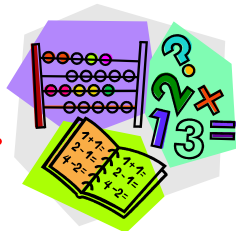
We will be improving our research skills in

Mathematics

This term we will focus on counting in multiples of 25, 100 and 1000. We will be recognising the place value of four digit numbers using thousands, hundreds, tens and ones. Next we will be adding and subtracting 3 digit numbers. We will also be identifying and describing 2d shapes using Lines of symmetry. We will also identify different fractions. We will be revising all the timestables.



Science

The Science for this term is States of Matter. We will be exploring the properties of



Solids, Liquids and Gases.

RE and PSCH

The RE for this term is "What do we know about the Bible?" We will be exploring where the Bible came from and what books it contains as well as listening to some of its stories and teachings.
