It is important that your child practices at least 3 times a week so that he or she makes as much progress as possible.



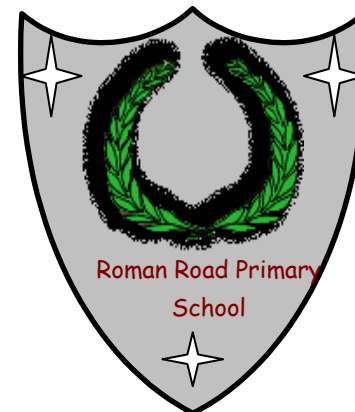

Dr. Barnardo, who set up a Ragged School at this time for the poor and homeless.



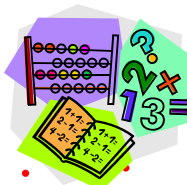
Mathematics

NEW BEGINNINGS is the theme for this term and the children will listen to stories about how other children made a new beginning at the start of term.

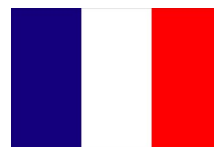
We will also be learning about jobs, salaries and how to manage money.

taking photographs of ourselves when we dress up as Victorians and make a class photo album.

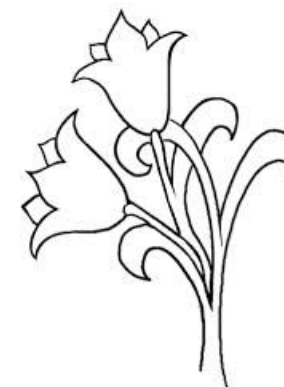
