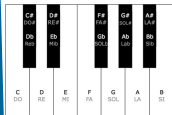


## Geography

weekly swimming lessons.

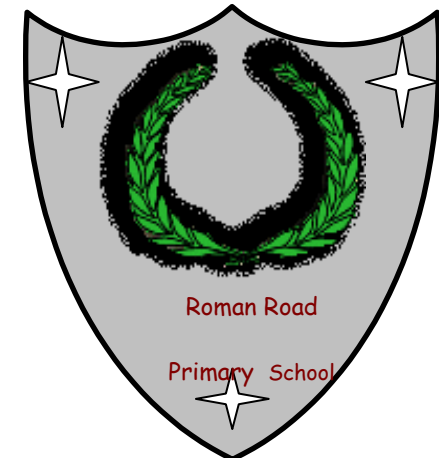
Indoor PE will be focusing on Gymnastics and how to perform a sequence of movements. Handball will be outside PE.

## English

This term we will be reading the narrative poem "The Highwayman". We will retell the story and act it out, thinking about the characters in the poem, and then write our own poems.



Later we will be researching Earth and Space and deciding on the categories to use to write our own non-chronological report about space.

## Mathematics

Identify, describe and represent the position of a shape following a reflection or translation.

Identify 3-D shapes, from 2-D representations.

Measure and calculate the perimeter of composite rectilinear shapes.

Distinguish between regular and irregular polygons based on reasoning about equal sides and angles.

Compare the area of rectangles and estimate the area of irregular shapes.

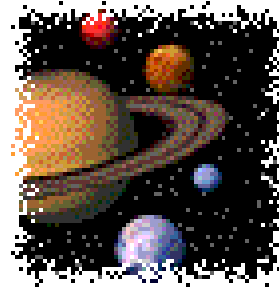
Recognise and use thousandths and relate them to tenths, hundredths and decimal equivalents.

Solve addition and subtraction multi-step problems.



## Science

The Science for this term is Earth and Space. We will be learning about the different planets as well as the Earth and the Moon and writing a report about them,



## RE and PSCH

The RE for this term is "Why do Christians celebrate Christmas?"

We will find out some of the traditional stories and customs associated with Christmas and then read the Christian story of the Nativity.



Getting On and Falling Out is the theme for this term and the children will listen to stories about how other children make friendships, argue and then make up.

We will also consider how to keep safe recognize danger and make appropriate risk assessments.
