We will continue swimming weekly.

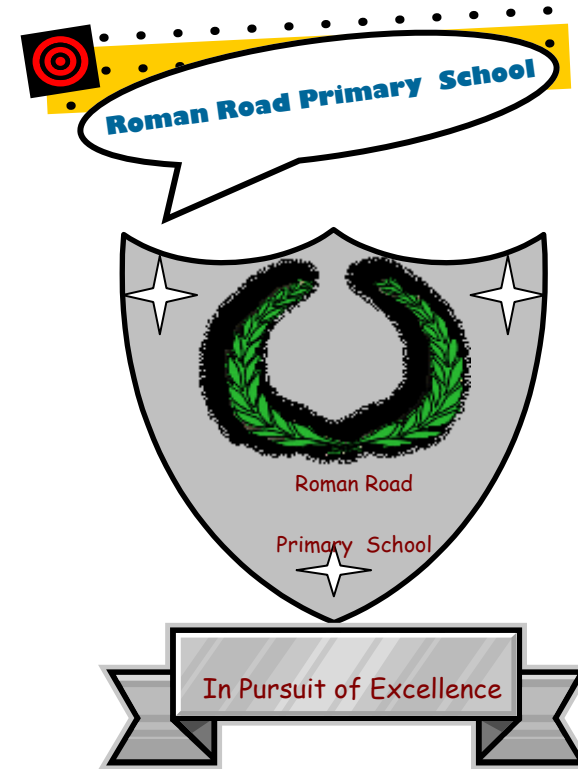
PE will be focusing on Handball and Gymnastics.

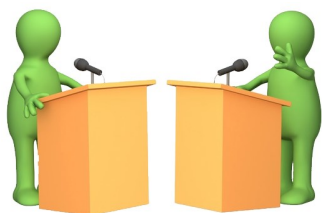

Read, write, order and compare numbers to at least 1,000,000.

Interpret negative numbers in context.

Solve problems involving converting between units of time.

Multiply numbers up to 4 digits by a one- or two-digit number using a formal written method, including long multiplication for two-digit numbers.

Multiply proper fractions and mixed numbers by whole numbers.
