It is important that your child practices at least 3 times a week so that he or she makes as much progress as possible.

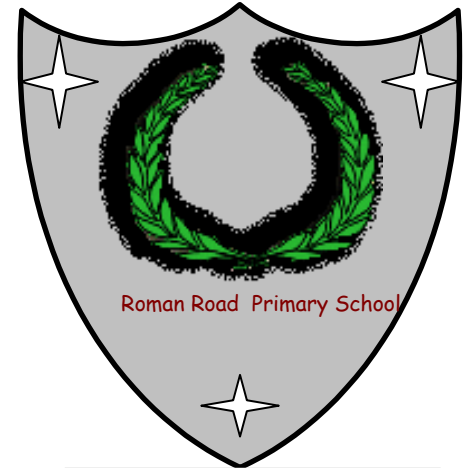
PE

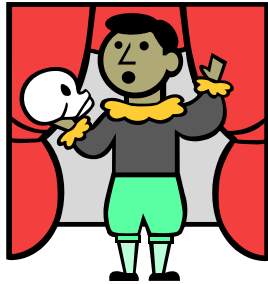

Generate and describe linear number sequences including the replacement of letters.

Express missing number problems algebraically.

Describe and draw 2D shapes Recognise, describe and build simple 3-D shapes, including making nets.

Calculate the area of parallelograms and triangles.

Calculate and interpret the mean as an average.

Getting on and Falling Out is the theme for this term and the children will listen to stories about how other children made friends, fell out and made up.

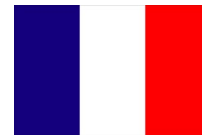
We will also find out about the global community and what it means to be a citizen in the world

DT

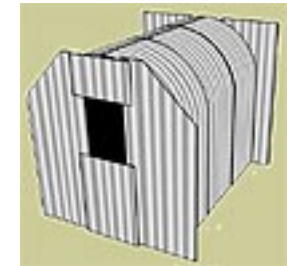
