## PE

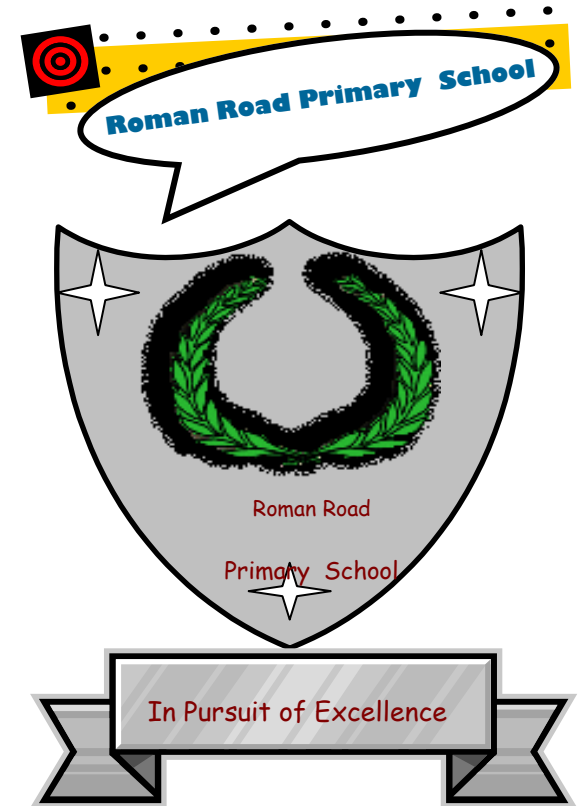
We will be developing our gymnastics skills in PE looking at the 9 Key Shapes.

## English

This term we will be reading mystery stories which build suspense, focusing on Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone.

We will then read and write an explanation text.

We will then read stories from other cultures, including, "The Librarian of Basra," and link it with our Geography.

## Mathematics

Identify common factors, common multiples and prime numbers. Use estimation to check answers to calculations. Pupils explore the order of operations using brackets. Identify the value of each digit in numbers given to three decimal places and multiply and divide numbers by 10, 100 and 1000 giving answers up to 3 dps. Compare and order fractions, including fractions  $> 1$ . Add and subtract fractions with different denominators and mixed numbers, using the concept of equivalent fractions. Solve problems using ratio and proportion and percentages. Solve scale factor problems of similar shapes.

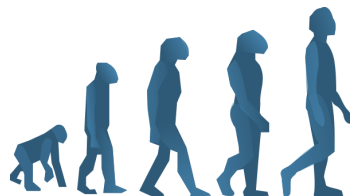
