

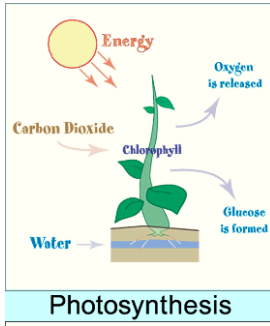
Reading

This term we will be reading everyday in order to develop our comprehension skills. We will be reading Myths and Legends and Non-chronological reports.

It is important that your child reads every day and completes their Reading Records.

Science

We will be learning about the processes of Living things including plants , animals and humans.



Writing

The children will be writing their own legend, following the story structure of introduction, problem, build up, climax, resolution and ending. We will describe characters and settings. Later we will write Non-Chronological reports and Discussion Texts about current world issues which links to the Geography and RE for this term.

Grammar

Pupils will learn how to write different complex sentences. They will learn how to use verbs, adverbs and adjectives.



Spelling

It is important that your child learns his or her spellings for 10 minutes every day.

Mathematics

We will:

Express missing number problems algebraically
Find pairs of numbers that satisfy an equation with two unknowns . Illustrate and name parts of circles, including radius, diameter and circumference and know that the diameter is twice the radius. Recognise when it is possible to use formulae for area and volume of shapes. Use, read, write and convert between standard units, using decimal notation to up to three decimal places Convert between miles and kilometres. Interpret and construct pie charts and line graphs and use these to solve problems.

PE

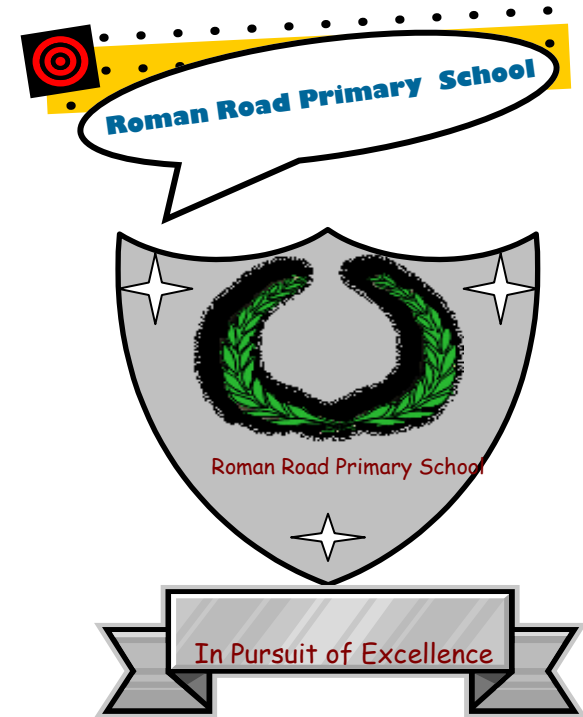
We will be developing our dance skills in PE focusing on dancing.
