### Dropping children off before school and collecting children after school

In Preschool, Nursery, Reception, Years 1 and 2 all children are to be collected by an adult. In years 3, 4, 5, 6 we would expect children to be collected by an adult, however, we will look at exceptional cases and if we have written permission from a parent then we may allow collection by a sibling who is over the age of 14. Children who are years 5 & 6 may go home by themselves. However, the school asks that any parent wishing their child to go home by themselves give us written permission. We do not give permission for children to come to school or go home by public transport on their own. When we talk about an adult, this is defined as someone who is over the age of 16 (proof may be required). To ensure that children are safeguarded in the morning we expect parents to bring their children to the school gates and see them in.

### SCHOOL CLOSURE

Parents/carers are reminded that the School will be closed for half term from Monday, 24th October and reopen on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> November 2016.

If your child/children are going trick or treating, during Halloween they should always be accompanied by a responsible adult.
