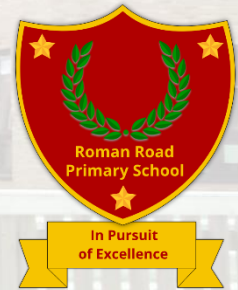

Parking and Safe Crossing of Road

Just a reminder that children need to be collected from the school gate in person, unless they walk home by themselves (years 5 and 6). Some parents have been waiting in their cars. We cannot send children over to the cars. This is for the safety of the children.

Only permit holders are allowed beyond the barrier. If you do have a parking permit and are parking close to the school, please switch off your engines while you are waiting, do not let them idle. As the barrier has been out of order, we have seen an increase in people using the private road. This is reserved for people with permits.

The barrier which is situated at the end of Roman Road (a few yards further on from the school entrance), is closed during the following times:

- 08:15 – 09:10
- 14:45 – 15:30

This will mean that non authorised vehicles will not be able to pass through the barrier.

The main reason for this being the health and safety of our children.

Inevitably this adds considerable strain to the public highway. To avoid this congestion I would ask all parents that live within a 1.2 mile **walking distance** to school to do so.

We ask parents not to park directly in front of the school. Not only does this cause congestion, but also blocks the pathway for children to cross safely in the morning and the afternoon.

Wearing of Face Masks

The school strongly recommends and expects parents to use masks during drop off and collection from school. We have introduced markers to allow for social distancing. The measures we have put in place are designed to keep you, and your children protected as much as possible. Wearing masks will limit the spread of COVID. Thank you for your support with this.
