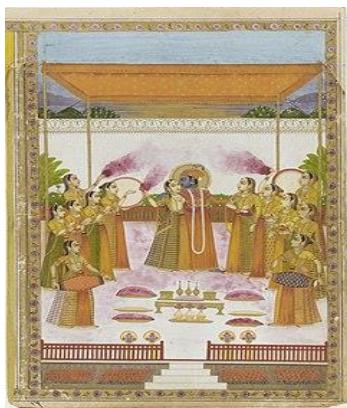
Staff Update
