

Finance Briefing Use of PE & Sport Grant 2020-21

Background

The PE & Sport Premium was introduced to help schools introduce a better PE curriculum and to assist the Government's aim to reduce obesity and improve general fitness for primary school children with the added benefit of this improving academic progress.

Funding is calculated on an academic year basis but the figures used in this report refer to a financial year

Funding Levels

Funding of 2020-21 financial year is £19,137. It should be noted the actual funding is paid for the academic year but the figure shown is adjusted for the financial year.

Use of PE & Sport Premium

Roman Road Primary School intends to continue to use funding in line with grant expectations.
