

ROMAN ROAD SCHOOL UNIFORM

At Roman Road, it is our policy that all students from Nursery to year 6 should wear school uniform when attending school. School uniform promotes a sense of identity and pride for students attending the school, it engenders a feeling of community and belonging, makes students feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance and is regarded as suitable and good value for money by most parents.

Below is a list of items needed for school uniform.

Grey bottoms – this can be trousers, shorts, skirt or dress (children in Nursery can wear grey jogging bottoms as this is easier for them to manage when using the toilet independently)



White top – this can be a polo t-shirt or shirt (for Reception and Nursery children, we recommend polo t-shirts as this is the easiest for them to manage).



Burgundy Jumper – this can be a round neck jumper, V neck jumper or cardigan (the first image shows the burgundy colour jumper should be).



Black shoes – Shoes must be suitable and safe for children to be able to run and be comfortable in (we recommend our Reception and Nursery children to wear shoes with Velcro fastening and not a shoe lace). All shoes must be closed toe.

PE Uniform:

Children in Reception to Year 6 will participate in PE once a week. Children must change into PE uniform to participate in PE. A list of our PE uniform is listed below:

White t-shirt



Black bottoms - this can be jogging bottoms, shorts or suitable leggings



Black plimsolls – We recommend children to wear plimsolls with Velcro fastening as these are more securely worn and safe).
