We will be following Unit 4 of the Music Express Course and singing in tune and in time.

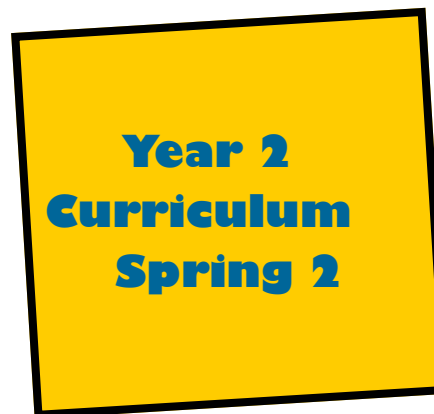


## PE

## Mathematics

Recall addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently and use related facts to 100. Add and subtract numbers including adding a 2-digit number and tens, two 2-digit numbers and 3 single digits and solving problems.

Understand and use numerator and denominator.

Write simple fractions and understand equivalence of  $\frac{1}{2}$  and  $\frac{2}{4}$ .

Compare, order, estimate and measure length and mass.

Use vocabulary to describe position, direction and movement.

Tell and write the time to 5 mins including quarter past/to.



## Science

The Science for this term is knowing the different types of plants, both flowering and non-flowering. We will also consider what is needed for plant growth.



## RE and PSICHE

The RE for this term will focus on Christianity looking at the festival of Easter and customs associated with it.



The PSICHE for this term is Good to be Me. We will think of all the positive things that make us who we are. We will learn how to express our emotions and manage our feelings when things don't go as planned.
