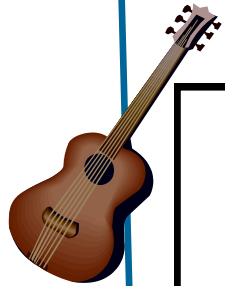


Music

It is important that your child practices at least 3 times a week so that he or she makes as much progress as possible.



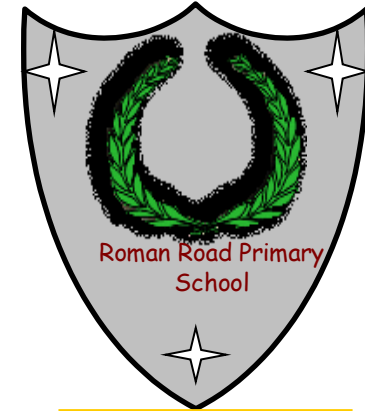

English

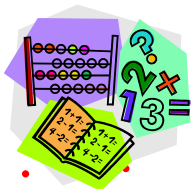
This term we will be reading a story set in Victorian Times in order to find out about the life of Victorian children in Britain.

Mathematics

Read, write, order and compare numbers to 1 million.
Count forwards/ backwards in steps of 10.
Read, write, order and compare numbers with up to 3 decimal places.
Add and subtract numbers with more than 4 digits and decimals using formal written method and solving multistep word problems.
Recall multiplication facts up to 12×12 .
Read, write and convert time between analogue and digital.



Science

The Science for this term is Forces.

We will find out about what makes things move, how they start and how they stop,



including the forces of friction and gravity.

We will be learning

French in line with the National Curriculum.



RE and PSICHE

The RE for this term is "How do Christians follow Jesus' example?" We will be finding out about how Christians follow Jesus and how they put their beliefs into practice.

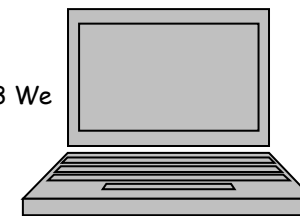
NEW BEGINNINGS is the theme for this term and the children will listen to stories about how other children made a new beginning at the start of term.
