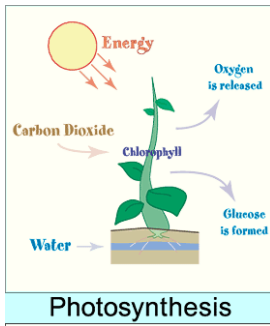
Reading

This term we will be reading everyday in order to develop our comprehension skills. We will be reading Non-chronological reports, Explanations, Balanced Arguments and Persuasion about a World Issue.

It is important that your child reads every day and completes their Reading Records.

Science

We will be learning about the processes of Living things including plants, animals and humans.



Writing

The children will be writing their own story, following the story structure of introduction, problem, build up, climax, resolution and ending. We will describe characters and settings. Later we will write Non-Chronological reports and Discussion Texts about current world issues which links to the Geography and RE for this term.

Grammar

Pupils will learn how to write different complex sentences. They will learn how to use verbs, adverbs and adjectives.

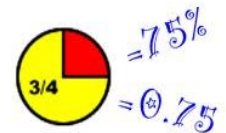


Spelling

It is important that your child learns his or her spellings for 10 minutes every day.

Mathematics

Solve addition and subtraction multi-step problems in contexts. Use, read, write and convert length, mass, volume and time and solve problems including the above. Solve ratio and proportion problems. Solve problems involving fractions, multiples and percentages. Identify 2D and 3D shape. Calculate the area and perimeter of parallelograms and triangles. Recognise angles on a straight line, or they are vertically opposite and find missing angles. Interpret and construct pie charts and line graphs and solve problems.



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
